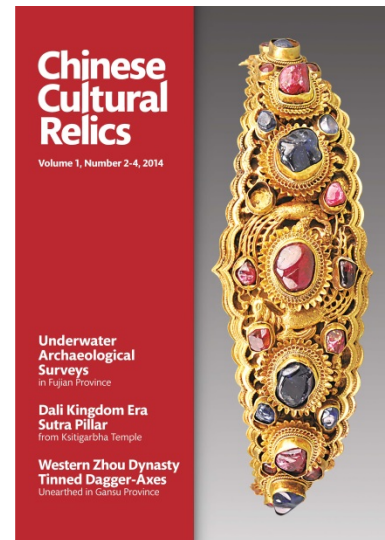

## Registration Now Open for the 2016 *Chinese Cultural Relics* CCR Translation Contest for Young Scholars

Contest finalists will not only be encouraged (with a travel stipend) to attend an award ceremony held during the 2016 Society for East Asian Archaeology Worldwide Conference (June 8-12 in Cambridge and Boston), but will also receive monetary awards (with prizes of \$1,000, \$750 and \$500, respectively), and will have their fully completed translations published in a forthcoming issue of CCR. In addition, all participants who demonstrate excellence in academic translation may be given the opportunity to join the CCR translation team.

**Online registration is now open!** The contest will begin on Thursday, January 7, 2016, when the translation materials will be made available. The deadline for submissions is Thursday, March 31, 2016.
